 - b. Members will be issued a print ready Certificate of Membership with the number.

Full-time Student Membership Policy
Amendment

Accepted February 7, 2018

A full-time student member must carry a normal full-time academic program as a registered undergraduate or graduate student in an institutionally approved course of study. A student carrying 12 or more credit hours in a fall and spring semester is considered a full-time student. The total cumulative period for a member to hold the MassCUE Student membership is limited to five years. Full-time students continuing at a graduate level may contact MassCUE for an extension.
