Keeping Students, Schools, & Libraries Connected During the Pandemic



How does it work?

The ECF Program will reimburse schools and libraries for the reasonable costs of eligible equipment and broadband connections used to help students, staff, and patrons who otherwise lack access to be able to engage in remote learning.

Who's Eligible?



Schools and libraries – including primary and secondary schools – that provided off-site broadband service and connected devices to students, staff, and patrons who would otherwise lack access during the COVID-19 health emergency.

What's Covered?



The Emergency Connectivity Fund will reimburse reasonable costs of eligible equipment such as Wi-Fi hotspots, modems, routers, devices that combine a modem and router, connected devices, and eligible broadband connections.

Important Things to Know:

- **Funding Window opens April 28th**
- **Window to file closes 5/13**
- WCA 100% invoices USAC up to \$400 per unit (no funding paid by the district)
- Google White Glove / Service / Google mgt all covered under the bundle
- If you applied for past funds, you are eligible for this round too
- Same rules as Wave1 & Wave2, units are for home student use
- We have current inventory at WCA
- WCA can hold inventory for summer delivery
- **\$1B in funding available**
- Important to file as early as possible before funds run out
